



APPEALS PANEL PROCEDURE FOR NETBALL EUROPE COMPETITIONS

Annual Competitions: U17, U21 and Open. All competitions to have a performance and development section

Every 4 years: WNCRQ – played to INF WNC regulations

The Terms of Reference for the Appeals Panels are within the NE Championship Regulations.

Appeals Panel

The Appeals Panel is made up of three members. One member being from the host country and the other two are members of the NE Management Committee. All three members of the panel must have relevant experience in respect of this area and will be approved by NE Management in advance of the competition. A reserve, who will be a member of NE Management, will also be named. All NE Management Panel members must be available and present for the whole of the competition.

A member of the NE Management will act as Chair of the Panel. The Chair of the Panel will also record and keep confidential, the nominations for the Player of the Competition and with the other Panel Members agree the winner. Nominations will be given to the Chair after each game.

Appointment of Panel Members

The Network Europe Technical Group (NETG) Lead will confirm the date and venue of each competition and will request the availability of Management.

At the same time the NE Competition Manager (NECM) will ask the Host Countries to name their Appeals Panel Member. Travel and accommodation costs of the Host Country Appeals Panel Member are the responsibility of the host country.

The NETG Lead will review the availability of the Panel Members and recommend the appointment based on availability and any previous attendance at NE competitions.

The NE Management will confirm the recommendations of the NETG Lead.

The NECM will make all necessary arrangements through liaison with the appointed Panel Members.
