

## ITID Assessment Guidelines revised December 2018

- Option 1 is a minimum of two assessment matches: the matches to be scheduled within a 3-month window of each other
- Option 2 is one assessment match with recent (defined as the last 6 months) ITP Assessor performance reports replacing the second assessment: the 3-month window starts from the date of the most recent performance report
- Standard of matches:
  - Matches (one or two) to be of an appropriate standard.
  - At least one of the matches must be at senior level e.g. VNSL, NE Open, International friendly; the second match must be of a standard approved by the ITPs.
  - The ITP Assessors will make the final decision as to whether the level of the match was of an appropriate standard.
  - For all NE countries, EN Super League matches are the default standard.
- The ITP Assessors to be different for each umpire for each match (an exception may be made where a Region is unable to comply with this guideline due to a lack of qualified ITPs).
- Only ITP Assessors can recommend but ITPCs can attend an assessment match as an observer for their CPD.
- A minimum mark of **17** to be attained by the nominee umpire on each match.
- The mark for matches must include a score of 1 or 2 in Game Management & Protocols, Communication & Sanctions and Minor infringements with no score of 4 in any Section.
- The ITP Assessors to also consider whether the nominee umpire demonstrates the appropriate potential, attitude & demeanour to be a future IUA.
- The ROC will liaise as appropriate with the ITP's, the Event organiser and the Umpires regarding the arrangements for assessment matches.
- ITPs are required to comply with the INF procedure(s) currently in force for the award of ITID status.
