

Medical Services at Netball Europe Events

Aims

- To enable athletes to participate to the best of their ability in a safe and supported environment
- To provide a timely and responsive service appropriate to the level of the needs of the athletes, umpires and team officials
- To work in a co-ordinated and supportive manner with NGB medical staff from participating federation
- To ensure compliance with INF anti-doping policies and the World Anti-doping code
- To work to the INF Medical Commission aims of:
 Promotion and protection of the health of players, as well as injury prevention and rehabilitation, by enhanced knowledge and skills for maximal performance of the sport of netball at all levels.

Responsibilities of Medical Services at Netball Europe Events

- Provide additional support to team medical personnel in emergency situation
- Provide medical support in the form of assessment and treatment in emergency situation in the absence of an appropriately trained health professional (HCPC Registered Physiotherapist or GMC Dr)
- Maintain accurate records of any assessment, intervention or onward referral in relation to athletes or officials participating within the tournament
- Provide medical support to officials involved within the tournament
