- Co-ordinate, administrate and facilitate local and regional meetings creating a network of connected clubs and partners to promote collaboration, sharing good practice and maximising efficiency of resources.
- Support clubs to achieve Minimum Standards to create an infrastructure of strong, sustainable, inclusive clubs.
- Support clubs to embed Wellbeing & Protection Standards ensuring compliance and identifying & facilitating training needs.
- Support and activate strong school to club and club to FE/HE links providing a pathway for lifelong participation and engagement.
- Support the activation of Netball Scotland's Volunteer Strategy.
- Work collaboratively with the NDM (Local Associations & Clubs) to identify a sufficient supply of workforce and volunteers to ensure the ambitions of Partners and Clubs are met.
- Work collaboratively with Netball Scotland's team of National Development Managers to support clubs across the pathway.
- Work collaboratively with facility partners to increase capacity for clubs in the community to enhance membership, engagement & participation.

Membership, Participation & Engagement

- Support the NDM team to increase membership, engagement & participation through activation and facilitation of national projects.
- Effectively utilise all Netball Scotland and partner platforms to engage existing members and attract new audiences showcasing the power of sport to actively improve the health, wellbeing, and resilience of the nation.
- Support NS's internal and external Equality Groups to achieve the priorities outcomes to change lives and reduce inequalities.

Reporting
